## Why we are setting up a new group...

As an Education and Childrens Services Department we work towards putting Children and Young People at the centre of everything we do. To give young people more opportunities to have a say in what we do we are setting up a new Young People's Management Board.

## What's the new group about...

As a group you will work with managers and decision makers from the County Council to evaluate and shape decisions made about your education and learning.

## When would it be...

We are hoping to hold the first meeting in September 2022. Meetings will be a mixture of face-to-face and online.

## Can you get involved...

Yes, if you are aged 14, 15 or 16 years old from Carmarthenshire and have got something to say about Education.

You can take part in training sessions, an overnight activity weekend, teambuilding activities, away days and meetings.

- get a gift voucher as a thank you for your time, hard work and commitment
